Recessed Meeting from November 15, 2006  
Final Public Hearing on 2007 Proposed Budget

Mayor Bentley called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM with the Flag Salute.

The Public Hearing on the Proposed Budget for 2007 was called to order.

Susan Strong and Mary Thornton both had questions regarding the Storm Water Fund—the reason for the creation of the fund and the budgeted expenditures included in the 2007 Proposed Budget. It was explained that the fund was established to help correct certain storm water problems in McCleary—the staffing necessary. It is also hoped that eventually funds could be used to match loans or grants from outside agencies.
