

AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
Formation of the Chehalis Basin Watershed  
Management Partnership and Designation of Lead Agency

WHEREAS, the governmental entities of the Chehalis River Basin are interested in forming a WRIA planning unit so that they are eligible to apply for and receive funds pursuant to Engrossed Substitute House Bill No. 2514 (Laws of 1998) and chapter 90.82 RCW; and

WHEREAS, the governmental entities became parties to an Intergovernmental Agreement dated August 31, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Agreement named Lewis County as the Lead Agency; and

WHEREAS, Lewis County requested that Grays Harbor County assume the Lead Agency role, which was confirmed by consensus of the Chehalis Basin Partnership during the December 3, 1999 meeting;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants recited therein, the parties agree and resolve as follows:

**6.0 Lead Agency**

The Intergovernmental Agreement, dated August 31, 1998, is amended to substitute Grays Harbor County as Lead Agency.

All other provisions of the Intergovernmental Agreement shall remain unchanged except as amended above in Section 6.0.
