
**CONDITIONS OF PERMIT**

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. The fire must be attended at all times by someone with the means and capability of extinguishing the fire. A garden hose connected to a water supply or other approved fire extinguishing equipment shall be readily available for use at open burning sites.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Maximum pile size is four feet by four feet by three feet in height. (4' wide x 4' long x 3' high).
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Only one pile shall be burned at a time, and each pile must be extinguished before igniting another.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. No material containing garbage, asphalt, dead animals, petroleum products, paints, rubber products, plastic paper (other than what is necessary to start a fire), cardboard, treated wood, construction debris, metal or any substance which when burned releases toxic emissions, dense smoke or obnoxious odors.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. If the fire creates a nuisance, it must be extinguished.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. Open burning shall not be conducted within 50 feet of any structure or other combustible material. Conditions, which could cause the fire to spread to within 5 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition. EXCEPTION: Clearance from structures and other combustible material is allowed to be reduced as follows.
  - a. Not less than 15 feet when burning is conducted in an approved burning appliance.
  - b. Not less than 25 feet when pile size is 3 feet or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in height.

IT IS UNLAWFUL to burn rubber products, plastics, paint, glue, asphalt, garbage, dead animals, petroleum products, treated wood, plywood, wafer-board, processed wood, cardboard, paper (other than to start a fire), or any similar products that create dense smoke. Any fire creating a nuisance must be extinguished.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. THIS PERMIT OR A COPY MUST BE AVAILABLE AT BURN SITE.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. YOU are responsible for any claims arising out of the activities performed under this permit, including claims arising from fire, smoke or water. It is the permittee's responsibility to adhere to State and Local burn bans.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 9. If fire escapes for any reason YOU here by voluntarily agree to hire personnel and equipment, at YOUR OWN expense, to fight and suppress the same and to pay the City of McCleary or any other approved fire fighting agency for any and all reasonable expenses incurred by its or them in fighting and suppressing the fire.
