How We Can Help

The Domestic Violence Center provides safety and support for you and your children. Our advocates can help in many ways:

- ◆ Providing safety planning and technology assistance to fit your needs.
- ◆ Provide emergency shelter for abused individuals and their children.
- ◆ Provide crisis intervention 24 hours a day
- ◆ Provide legal advocacy and justice system support
- ◆ Provide advocacy (with permission from the client) with other social service agencies.
- ◆ Assist with exploring options, choices and referrals to other social service providers.
- ◆ Provide Group and individual advocacy.

If you are a victim of domestic violence, you can ask the County Prosecuting Attorney to file a criminal complaint. You also have the right to file a petition in any Superior Court requesting an order for protection from domestic abuse, which could include any of the following:

- * An order restraining your abuser from further acts of abuse.
- ◆ We may provide an advocate for court support if needed.
- * An order preventing your abuser from entering your residence, school, business, or place of employment.
- ◆ An order awarding you or the other parent custody of / or visitation with minor children in your custody.

The forms you need to obtain an order are available in any superior court or online. The Domestic Violence Center of Grays Harbor can help. We have trained Advocates available 24 hours per day that are committed in providing advocacy to all individuals.
